Margunn Aanestad is Professor of Information Systems at the University of Agder and affiliated with the University of Oslo. Her research, which has been published in *ISR*, *MISQ*, *JSIS*, *JAIS*, *ISJ*, etc. has targeted the sociotechnical complexity of digital infrastructures, with a main empirical orientation towards the healthcare sector. She received her PhD in informatics from the University of Oslo.

Monica Adya

Monica Adya is the Dean of the Rutgers School of Business–Camden. Prior to this role, she served as chair of the Management department at Marquette University’s College of Business. Her research interests include participation and experiences of girls and women in information technology careers. She has received recognition for her pedagogical innovations by the *Decision Science Institute* and *American Council of Education*. She received her PhD in Management Information Systems from Case Western Reserve University.

Suresh Chalasani

Suresh Chalasani is a Professor at the University of Wisconsin-Parkside. He is the founding Academic Director for the first competency-based Business degree offered within the UW System. He has received multiple research and teaching grants from the National Science Foundation and the University of Wisconsin System. He received his PhD from the University of Southern California.

Wynne W. Chin

Wynne W. Chin is the C.T. Bauer chaired Professor of Decision and Information Sciences in the C.T. Bauer College of Business at the University of Houston. He is credited for introducing the Partial Least Squares Path Modeling (PLS) method and methodology of usage to business disciplines generally and the IS discipline specifically. He was awarded a Fellow of the Association of Information Systems in 2013. He received his PhD in Computers and Information Systems from the University of Michigan.

Christophe Elie-Dit-Cosaque

Christophe Elie-Dit-Cosaque is full Professor of Management Information Systems (MIS) at Université des Antilles (Martinique, France). He was formerly full professor of MIS and Vice-president in charge of International Affairs at Université Paris Dauphine - PSL. He obtained a PhD in Management and a PhD of Computer Information Systems conjunctly at Paris Dauphine - PSL and Georgia State University.
